

## OFFICIAL 2017 TRAILER RACE RULES

NOTICE: ALL EQUIPMENT IS SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF IRWINDALE SPEEDWAY OFFICIALS. ALL CARS MUST PASS A PRE-COMPETITION INSPECTION. NO EQUIPMENT WILL BE CONSIDERED AS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY REASON OF HAVING PASSED THROUGH INSPECTION.

1. Tow cars must comply with the Irwindale Speedway Trailer Race rules.
2. Trailer must be minimum 10 feet in length measured from hitch ball socket.
3. Trailer gross weight, including load, must be a minimum 500 lbs.
4. Single ball attachment, 2 inch maximum.
5. No safety chains, attachment at ball may be reinforced.
6. Trailer must be in solid working order. No sharp objects or projectiles.
7. Starting position priority will be given to longer trailers.
8. Trailers may be constructed of other cars by welding a bar to the front of a compact car and remove front wheels. Cars converted to be towed as a trailer must have the fuel tanks removed.
9. Carnage is welcome, but within discretion. Please consider the safety of the fans and other drivers. If your car and trailer does NOT pass safety inspection, you will NOT be allowed to participate.
10. Vehicles: Open to all makes of vehicles however subject to approval by Irwindale Speedway Competition Department.
11. Each competitor is solely responsible for the effectiveness of personal safety equipment used during an event. IRWINDALE SPEEDWAY IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE EFFECTIVENESS OF ANY PERSONAL SAFETY EQUIPMENT.
12. Tow cars are required to have 2 door bars on driver side, plus a spreader bar behind driver seat. Recommend a 4 point cage with 3 door bars on each side.
13. All vehicles and trailers must be free to debris and loose ballast.
14. All reinforcements to tow vehicle must be inside and not protrude outside the body of the tow vehicle.
15. Vehicle Removal
  - a) All participating cars and trailers must be removed from the infield/oval track at the end of the racing event. If you leave your car or trailer on-site, prior arrangements must be made with Mike Atkinson, Race Director at 626.407.8661. NO EXCEPTIONS.
